 - a. Facilities -
 - i. Jay Campbell - Associate Vice Chancellor for Facilities Management & Planning
 1. Parking- Colorado legislature makes it a requirement for institutions of higher education to charge for parking
 - a. Faculty who pay for parking passes at Anschutz can park at designated lots in Boulder with their pass
 - b. Students are not eligible for reciprocal parking passes
 2. On campus shuttle runs from 4:30am-5:30pm Monday-Friday, is free to take employees/students to and from the light rail station
 3. Zip Car is coming soon to campus- car that can be rented for an hourly rate
 4. Parking is free on weekends/overnight, but employees/students must contact the Parking Office Operations to give them their license plate
 5. EV stations are primarily in the Henderson Parking Garage- they are planning to add more

 1. Lighting Tour to ensure the campus is well-lit
 - a. West Rock Lot, Red Cross Memorial Dark Areas, and Pharmacy and Library have gotten lighting repair as a result of last year's Lighting Tour
 - b. Moving towards LED lighting since it is better for the environment than other options
 - c. 17th Place --> Montevue is the current project for better lighting since it is quite dark
 2. In regard to questions about what happened to the shuttle that was taking students from CU Denver/National Jewish Hospital to Anschutz: this was discontinued since it cost 300k per year (around \$25/student/trip) and there are no plans to start the shuttles up again
