

Event Overview

The 10th annual University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus Block Party will be held on Wednesday, September 18, 2024, in the heart of the CU Anschutz Medical Campus. This free event is a community-building festival designed to pull together all CU Anschutz Medical Campus students, clinicians, researchers and staff from the university, Children's Hospital Colorado, University of Colorado Hospital and CU Medicine – numbered at more than 17,000 employees and 4,000 students. 2013's inaugural event attracted nearly 2,000 people over three hours and was deemed a huge success by all who participated. The 2023 Block Party was the biggest ever, with 140 booths, more than 3,500 attendees, and a musical performance by special guest Esmé Patterson.



The Block Party is held in Bonfils Circle on the south side of the Fitzsimons Building, conveniently located in the middle of the campus. Attendees at past events experienced a variety of interactive and informative booths showcasing the campus's units and introducing them to external community partners. We've featured live music by great local bands such as Atomga, The Belle Jar, Pandas and People, Wildermiss, New Currency, IzCalli and The Epilogues, dance performances and a mountain bike stunt show. Attendees have enjoyed food from some of Colorado's most popular food trucks and local restaurants. Activities such as a mobile zip line, ropes course, corn hole, ladder toss, volleyball and inflatable games provided endless opportunities to relax and have fun in the late summer sunshine.
